Ruby red with purple reflections. Intense bouquet with hints of cherries and blackberries, soaked in mint tobacco, slightly spicy. The spicy taste makes this wine sweet to the mouth, finishing with notes of cocoa and coffee. Persistent length of flavor & aftertaste.

Barolo is universally considered the king of wines in Piedmont! Garnet red with orange highlights, the bouquet is ethereal, pleasing and intense, with spicy notes and hits of leather. The wine is full, mouth-filling, full-bodied, with excellent tannin structure and fresh acidity.

#### Villa Al Cortile Brunello di Montalcino DOCG \$145 Tuscany, Italy




Ages in various oak vessels for 24 months. The bouquet is sustained and round with complex notes of liquorice and ripe black cherry, both powerful and classy. Full, ripe, spicy black skinned fruit on the palate, smooth tannins expose great elegance.

#### Tenute Rossetti Chianti Classico Riserva Tuscany, Italy



Brilliant ruby red with garnet highlights. On the nose aromas of cherries, red plums, and currants are layered over notes of earth, rose petals and leather. On the palate, the wine is full – bodied showing excellent structure with firm, integrated tannins and plenty of spice on the long finish

#### Baladin Isaac 5% ABV Italian Craft Beer \$13.9 330mL bottle

Italy it typically known for it's pale, inoffensive lagers. However, scratch that surface and there's interesting things to be found. Like brewer Matterino 'Teo' Musso's Piozzo-based Baladin in the northwest of Italy, halfway between Turin and Nice.

Named for his son, the Isaac is a self-described "blanche with mediterranean aromas". Meaning a Belgian-style wheat beer with the traditional orange peel and coriander additions; light, grassy hoppiness; and a slight, citrusy sourness that distinguishes it from its more northern cousins.
